#Viewing a Wider World (6 cr)

Viewing a Wider World courses are listed in the undergraduate catalog. One of the two VWW's must be FCS 449V, while the other one may be in any college except Agriculture, Consumer & Environmental Sciences (ACES). For Honors options, go to Honors College website or Honors Course Lookup.

Courses in Italics can be taken as Courses by Contract. Non-Honors courses may count as upper level Honors courses by contracting the course. This is a mechanism for adding an "honors dimension" to a course that is not listed as an honors course. The contract allows honors students to convert a regular non-honors course into an honors course that counts toward graduation with University Honors. Contact the Honors College for more information. You may take up to 6 upper division credits by contract.

Courses in **BOLD** are guaranteed to transfer to other New Mexico colleges/universities as part of the statewide common core.
